Class 1 - 09:00 - Main Arena - Power & Speed

Rule 275. Table A4. Speed 0mpm. Start Height 1.30m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

The starting order must be drawn.

The course is divided into two sections. The first or power section consists of five to seven obstacles of progressively increasing severity designed to test power and precision at each obstacle individually. This section is jumped as an Accumulator competition in accordance with Rule 274 not against the clock with a time limit of two minutes.

On completion of the power section the bell will be rung if the competitor has NOT scored the maximum possible number of points over this section. The competitor must then retire. If the bell is not rung, the competitor proceeds straight to the second, or speed, section of the course. This consists of six to eight obstacles to be jumped under Table A4 or Table C.

The start and finish must be indicated separately for each section. Finish of power section to be start of speed section. Automatic timing is only obligatory for the speed section.

The competition is decided by faults and time over the speed section. In the event of insufficient competitors reaching the speed section, minor placings are decided by the highest number of points scored over the power section. If no competitor reaches the speed section and in the event of equality of points over the power section, there will be a jump-off over the speed section to decide the winner.

Prizes: 1st: £400.00, 2nd: £300.00, 3rd: £200.00, 4th: £150.00, 5th: £95.00, 6th: £55.00, Total: £1,200.00. Entry Fee = £70.00 (Pre-Entry £50.00)

Class 2 - Main Arena - Area Trial

Rule 293. Table A9. Speed 375mpm. Start Height 1.50m. **DRAWN ORDER**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses in Grades A & B to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members. This competition may not be restricted to invited riders or limited to less than 40 entries.

Qualifies for: The Queen Elizabeth II Cup at the Longines Royal International Horse Show.

Numbers to qualify: The top 20 riders on the Area/International Trials points list, for the period 1 April - 30 September.

Points will be awarded to riders placed 6th= or higher in Area Trials on the following scale; riders placed equal will share equally the total points attributable to the combined placings (for example, four riders placed 4th equal receive: 8+4+2+0 divided by 4 = 3.5 points each).

1st 64 points

2nd 32 points

3rd 16 points

4th 8 points

5th 4 points

6th 2 points

Points are awarded to each rider as the result of his/her best six results on points in Area Trials held during the qualifying period. Visiting Members are eligible to compete in Area Trial competitions, but will not be awarded points.

For the purposes only of calculating points, the placings of Visiting Members will be disregarded and points will be awarded to the remaining competitors according to their adjusted placings once this has been done.

Rule 290.15 - Pre-Entry Drawn Order

Pre-entries may possibly be accepted before 9.00am providing that the number of entries are less than 60 (with the exception of County shows). Once entries reach 60 before 9.00am the class will be closed. Any entries taken on the day must compete first in the drawn order.

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £78.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 4 - Denbigh Ring - Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 318. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period).

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £78.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 5 - Denbigh Ring - Senior British Novice Championship – First Round/90cm Open

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Novice:

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2015 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6

Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four Senior British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings

for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

90cm Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £78.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 6 - Denbigh Ring - Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 320. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World,

European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds

Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £79.00. **Entry Fee = £21.00 (Pre-Entry £16.00)**

Class 7 - Denbigh Ring - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

1.00m Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £24.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £106.00. **Entry Fee = £22.00 (Pre-Entry £17.00)**

Class 9 - Denbigh Ring - Dodson & Horrell 1.10m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round

Rule 324. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible

(excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.10m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.10m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.10m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.10m Second Round competition.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, Total: £122.00. **Entry Fee = £22.00 (Pre-Entry £17.00)**

Class 10 - Denbigh Ring - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED MILLS In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £20.00, Total: £120.00. **Entry Fee = £22.00 (Pre-Entry £17.00)**

Class 11 - 09:00 - Flint Ring - Pony Intro 70cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £75.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 12 - Flint Ring - Pony British Novice Championship - First Round /80cm Open

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Novice:

For registered ponies in Grade JD, that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

80cm Open:

For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members

If combined with an open:

In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £75.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 13 - Flint Ring - Pony Discovery -First Round/90cm Open

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open:

For registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £75.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £15.00)**

Class 14 - Flint Ring - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round.

The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination.

Ponies may compete in one section only.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £79.00. **Entry Fee = £21.00 (Pre-Entry £16.00)**

Class 15 - Flint Ring - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round.

The Open Section is for registered ponies in Grade JA, JC, JD to be ridden by Junior Members. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination.

British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling applies to this class, in accordance with Rule 102.15. Failure to

comply will incur disqualification.

GENERAL RULES CONTINUED

12. All persons in charge of Horses, Cattle, etc., on behalf of the Exhibitor must be acquainted with the various particulars required to be carried out regarding the Stock they have in their charge, and must be ready to bring out their animals when required to do so by the Stewards. Exhibitors are responsible for seeing that their animals are led by competent persons, and no person under the age of 16 years shall be permitted to handle stallions.
13. The Hon. Showyard Director shall have power to elect his own Superintendents and Stewards, who must be Non-Exhibitors in their own Section. All officials at the Show to work under the supervision of the Hon. Showyard Director.
14. All protests must be delivered in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the judging of the Class, unless a satisfactory reason is assigned for the delay, together with a fee of £25. All protests will be heard by the Management Committee within one month after the day of the Show except that, whenever possible, protests will be considered and settled on the Showground by the Hon. Showyard Director and the various Superintendents who will report such decision to the Management Committee at their next meeting.
15. The Society will most anxiously care for the safety of the exhibits, and for any other property entrusted to them, but it must be distinctly understood by the Exhibitors and Purchasers of any exhibits and all other persons, that the Society will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any exhibit, boxes, hampers, collars, or any other property during transit or at the Exhibition whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, nor for any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants, or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
16. The Parking of vehicles on the Showyard site will not be permitted.
17. All Exhibitors and their employees, and all other persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to the rules and regulations as interpreted by the Management Committee of the Denbighshire and Flintshire Agricultural Society Ltd.
18. No additional classes shall be added to the Schedule after publication except any of a minor nature and that only at the consent of the Hon. Showyard Director and his Officers.
19. Postponement or abandonment. Exhibitors shall not have any claim against the Society or any member of the Society in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever consequent upon the Show failing (for whatever reason) to be held.
20. Entry fees. Under no circumstance will Entry fees be returned in the case of cancellation of entries by an exhibitor

or postponement or cancellation of the Show for whatever reason.

BY ORDER OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

21. The Showyard Director has the discretion to change the timing of Judging classes and location as and when necessary.

22. This Show will be run in accordance with welsh government regulations current at the time and all exhibitors must comply fully with guidelines laid down. Any exhibitor or exhibit not conforming will be refused entry to the show fields and no refunds will be made.
