GENERAL RULES

Showground Holding Number 56/045/8002

VAT Registration No: 160 2583 84

1. No Prizes shall be offered from the funds of the Society which have not been sanctioned by the Management Committee, and the Society reserves to itself the power to withhold any Prize or Prizes where the Judges say there is not sufficient merit. **Supreme winning exhibits are expected to attend Grand Parade or prize money will be forfeited.** All classes are open to the United Kingdom except where stated.
2. Only the signed the Judges Books are accepted by the Society as evidence that a prize has been awarded.
3. 1st and 2nd Prize Winners only, in appropriate Classes, go forward for their Section Championship and Grand Parade. 1st & 2nd Prize-winners must appear in the Grand Parade. Livestock may not be removed from the Showground before the end of the Grand Parade or prize money may be forfeit.
4. The decision of the Judges in all cases will be final, except where fraud, misrepresentation or breach of the Rules is discovered. In the case of any dispute as to the height of the animal exhibited the current rules of the Joint Measurement Scheme Ltd. Will apply which can be obtained from the Secretary of the Joint Measurement Scheme Ltd., British Equestrian Centre, Kenilworth, CV8 2LR.
5. In the case of any dispute as to the age of any animal entered as being of a specified age the Steward shall call in the Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the Society for the purpose of whose decision (unless the animal has been accepted for Registration by its Herd, Stud or Flock Book Society) shall be final, and such animal if not eligible for the class in which it is entered, shall be disqualified.
6. The Society, acting through the Management Committee, reserves the right to refuse any entries without assigning a reason for so doing, and to cancel or abandon any class or section at any time prior to or on the day of the Annual Show, if there are fewer than three exhibitors.
7. All stock competing must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor and must have been owned and in his possession at least TWO MONTHS previous to the day of the Show, except where otherwise stated. All exhibitors are required to have adequate insurance and public liability cover for their stock.
8. No animal shall have its teats sealed during the Show nor shall the udder be in any way 'faked'. Groups – animals should already have been entered and shown in previous classes.
9. All Bulls over 10 months must be secured by a ring in the nose, and with staff or chain attached, otherwise they will not be admitted to the field. Cattle will not be admitted without ties to secure them to the posts. Please refer to safety policy statement. Bulls must be handled by 2 persons over 16 years of age. In hand Stallions should be shown by handlers over 16 years on Showday.
10. The Stock exhibited must not be distinguished during judging by any means which denotes their ownership, but solely by a number Ticket fixed to each Exhibit which will be sent by the Secretary previous to the Show and will correspond with the number in the Catalogue.
11. No Substitution of animals will be allowed after closing date of entries, except where the affiliated society approves the change and in the Jumping Classes as permitted under British Show jumping Rule 73.9.

12. All persons in charge of Horses, Cattle, etc., on behalf of the Exhibitor must be acquainted with the various particulars required to be carried out regarding the Stock they have in their charge, and must be ready to bring out their animals when required to do so by the Stewards. Exhibitors are responsible for seeing that their animals are led by competent persons, and no person under the age of 16 years shall be permitted to lead a Bull over the age of 10 months.
13. The Hon. Showyard Director shall have power to elect his own Superintendents and Stewards, who must be Non-Exhibitors in their own Section. All officials at the Show to work under the supervision of the Hon. Showyard Director.
14. All protests must be delivered in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the judging of the Class, unless a satisfactory reason is assigned for the delay, together with a fee of £25. All protests will be heard by the Management Committee within one month after the day of the Show except that, whenever possible, protests will be considered and settled on the Showground by the Hon. Showyard Director and the various Superintendents who will report such decision to the Management Committee at their next meeting.
15. The Society will most anxiously care for the safety of the exhibits, and for any other property entrusted to them, but it must be distinctly understood by the Exhibitors and Purchasers of any exhibits, livestock, and all other persons, that the Society will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or detention of, or damage to any exhibit, boxes, hampers, collars, or any other property during transit or at the Exhibition whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, nor for any act or omission of themselves, their officers, servants, or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
16. The Parking of vehicles on the Showyard site will not be permitted.
17. All Exhibitors and their employees, and all other persons admitted to the Showground shall be subject to the rules and regulations as interpreted by the Management Committee of the Denbighshire and Flintshire Agricultural Society Ltd.
18. No additional classes shall be added to the Schedule after publication except any of a minor nature and that only at the consent of the Hon. Showyard Director and his Officers.
19. Postponement or abandonment. Exhibitors shall not have any claim against the Society or any member of the Society in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever consequent upon the Show failing (for whatever reason) to be held.
20. Entry fees. Under no circumstance will Entry fees be returned in the case of cancellation of entries by an exhibitor or postponement or cancellation of the Show for whatever reason.
BY ORDER OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
21. The Showyard Director has the discretion to change the timing of Judging classes and location as and when necessary.
22. This Show will be run in accordance with Welsh government regulations current at the time and all exhibitors must comply fully with guidelines laid down. Any exhibitor or exhibit not conforming will be refused entry to the show fields and no refunds will be made.

CONDITIONS

1. A Spoon and a Rosette for the Best Mare or Filly and a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Stallion (provided there is a separate class(es) for Stallions) exhibited by in the Shire classes.
2. The winner of the Special Prize must be a member of the Shire Horse Society. Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has either been suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society, or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions, or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
3. No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year. The National Shire Horse Show being the only exception.

4. THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.

5. The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.

6. The Council reserves the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society.

Young Handler Accumulator Competition

The Shire Horse Society will once again be running the SHS Young Handler's Accumulator Award in 2020. Points relative to placings will be awarded to those young handlers who are 2022 members of the Shire Horse Society. The winner will be announced at the end of the year. Points will be awarded to the top five, with points awarded as follows:- 1st-5 points, 2nd-4 points, 3rd- 3 points, 4th-2 points and 5th- 1 point. The Champion Young Handler with the most points at the end of the year will win the trophy. Affiliated shows must submit the results of the Young Handler classes when they submit their Silver Spoon award forms.

Those taking part in the above should be Junior members of the Society and are able to join mid-season if they are not already members. Points will only count once membership is taken up and points will not be back dated. Junior memberships are £10 per annum and are open to those that have not attained their 18th birthday

MILKING FACILITIES AVAILABLE

1. Calving. An animal calving at full term or showing signs of abnormal discharge will be placed immediately in the approved isolation accommodation or returned to its premises or origin. As there will be insufficient time to obtain a result from an approved laboratory it is not possible for such an animal to be tested and returned to Show lines, or take any further part in the Show.
2. Abortion. In the event of an abortion occurring at the Show a BS27 form will be served on the owner or person in charge, requiring isolation and disinfection precautions to be taken. An investigation involving a full range of samples will be instigated. Arrangements will be made for the animal under investigation and also animals from the same registered premises to be returned home as soon as possible.
